- 1. No suckers from 2-year cane to be exhibited.
- 2. No cane to be topped except in specials 3 and 4.
- 3. All entries to be grown by or on behalf of the exhibitor
- 4. Where there is one exhibit only in any one class, that exhibit shall be awarded first prize; where there are only two exhibits, first and second prizes shall be awarded: where there are three exhibits in classes for which three prizes are allotted first, second and third prizes shall be awarded; provided that in the opinion of the judges, the standard of the exhibit or exhibits is sufficiently high enough to merit the awards.
- 5. All entries to be grown on cane land assigned to Condong Mill.
- 6. Entries in productivity competition and weight and ccs competition will be limited to those growers who have two or more entries in classes 1-15.
- 7. All entries must have at least 1½ meters, or 5ft, of cane.
- 8. All entries to be delivered on Thursday 31st October 2024 (the day before the show). No entries accepted on Friday 1st November.
- 9. All entries in weight and ccs competition, Multiple varieties- one sample per variety to be delivered to Mill glasshouse by 3:30pm Thursday 31st October 2024.
- 10. No 2-year old cane accepted.
- 11. Prize presentation at approximately 2:30pm Saturday 2nd November.

Prize money not collected by 8:00 pm Saturday 2nd November will be forfeited.
