

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

Exhibitors must adhere to the conditions of entry to the Showground and the rules and regulations of the MGBA, as they are bound by these terms. The application for entry and the rules and regulations shall constitute the whole agreement upon which entries are submitted. The exhibitor (including team) certifies that each animal exhibited by them is duly registered and either their property absolutely or is under their absolute care and control. The Committee/Show Management reserves the right to alter or amend the program.

NO REFUNDS ALLOWED. Studs with emailed entries will still be responsible to pay outstanding entry fees if not attending show.

The MGBA and Show has the power to evict any exhibitor from the showground in the event of a breach of the conditions of entry to the showground, rules and regulations and/or the MGBA Show Schedule.

ACKNOWLEDGEMENT, RELEASE AND INDEMNITY: Each person enters the showground at their own risk and is responsible for all property, animals, and children brought onto the showground under their care.

In entering, competitors and exhibitors agree to abide by any decision of the MGBA or Show Society Committee and agree to compete/exhibit at their own risk and to indemnify and keep indemnified the MGBA & Show Society and their Committee, Officials, Members and Volunteers against all claims, suits, actions or demands which may be brought against them in respect of any injuries or other loss sustained in the course of competing and\or exhibiting in any events and/or classes and agree to exonerate the MGBA & the Show Society Inc., including officials from all

responsibility and from all loss or injury whether from alleged negligence or otherwise.

AGE OF MINIATURE GOAT EXHIBITS

Age of animals will be calculated as at the first day of the show (show day).

BIO-SECURITY AND TRANSPORT DOCUMENTATION

Exhibitors must complete all documentation required and submit at bump in/inspection

- National Goat Health Statement

Footrot – the answers in section 3 for questions 6, 7 and 8 must be YES. It is the exhibitors responsibility to follow all DPI and governing bodies' state rules and requirements for tick/disease as well as movement of goats between states and to and from MGBA shows.

MGBA BIO-SECURITY RULES:

- All animals must be serviceably sound, in good condition and well groomed. Transport vehicles must be clean and meet biosecurity requirements.
- Sick goats are not permitted on grounds.
- Any animal found to be carrying ticks or lice and all animals that belong to the same exhibitor must be removed from the grounds.
- All goats must be free of signs of foot rot.
- A "National Goat Health Declaration" must be completed and accompany entry forms.

A minimum Assurance Rating of 2 (RD1 status) in part A will require evidence of whole herd negative test results (animals over 12 months of age) within the preceding 6 months of any show or event.

A minimum assurance rating of 3 and above in part A are required to be Check Tested (in part B) - all animals exhibited that are over 12 months must have tested⁽¹⁾ clear for CAE and Johne's disease in the past 12 months or be in a CAE and/or JD accredited herd⁽²⁾ (including WA – no longer a JD free state).

A minimum total assurance rating of 4 is required to be eligible for participation.

- All animals over 12 months as of the date of show, must have tested clear for CAE and Johne's Disease within past 12 months (see note 1).
- All animals under 12 months as of the date of show, that are not tested require clear test results from both parents (unless parent/s are IMPORTED donor/s).
- JD vaccinated goats require testing via fecal culture.
- Copies of the test results must be submitted via email at the time of entry and form part of eligibility and a copy attached to relevant signed goat health declarations (all exhibitors). Test results must identify the entered goat/s.
- By signing the entry form, Exhibitors declare that your animals meet the CAE/JD negative check tested/accredited requirements and declare that they have not been in contact with or in the proximity (note 2) of untested animals (note 3) nor in contact with the uncleaned and non-disinfected facilities, vehicles or equipment used by any non-accredited herds or untested/infected animals or contaminated land in the preceding 12mths. Any milk used to feed kids must come from accredited herds or be pasteurized or spray dried (note 4).
- Separation of studs / exhibitor groups to prevent movement of faeces or contaminated food, water or bedding and preventing animal to animal contact using a 2m distance between pens or a solid partition (eg: tidy grey tarp, boards, specifically made vinyl panel sheet etc that will prevent contact). Exhibitors are solely responsible for providing adequate supervision of animals at the venue. Restrict animals to designated areas by tethering or penning when not being led. Animals must not be subject to unsupervised handling or access by the general public.

Prompt removal of fecal material - regularly removed to no access plastic lined bins. This is particularly important in laneways and judging areas. Equipment must be cleaned regularly and stored at or in the bin (each stud responsible to clean up after themselves).

- Milk must be suitably caught, contained and removed from grounds and procedures on animals are not permitted at shows or other MGBA events (workshops excluded).

The exhibitor is solely responsible to ensure they meet and manage requirements of biosecurity and their accreditation scheme/s (where applicable) when attending MGBA shows or events. The Australian Johne's Disease Market Assurance Program for Goats (Goat MAP) SHOW, SALE & EXHIBITION CERTIFICATE OF COMPLIANCE "Provided by Agricultural Shows Australia as part of the National JD Program" form can be obtained from relevant website and used for each venue as a check sheet by exhibitors or their representative(s).

- Notes: (1) negative test to JD/CAE within 12 months or from a herd following an approved accreditation/biosecurity program. A copy of laboratory test results with animal's names/tags or if not available, a copy of the laboratory test results with a letter from the veterinary surgeon who collected the samples with the goat's names/tags/identification methods or copy of the relevant

accreditation certificate. Any laboratory test result that shows a positive or inconclusive result must be further investigated by a veterinary surgeon and this report must have attached to it the final report of such investigation e.g. a negative fecal test for JD or subsequent negative blood test for CAE. (2) animals are not permitted to make contact with untested animals - unloading/loading; walkways; pens; yards; feed/water receptacles; equipment; transport; show ring; etc. at any time or testing is void. Contact is defined as being within 2 metres unless separated by a solid barrier. (3) Animals: goats; sheep; deer; cattle; camel; bison; llama; alpaca (4) goats that have been in contact with untested animals their manure or unpasteurised goat's milk from non-accredited sources must be held in isolation and be blood tested twice at an interval of 6-12 months to be eligible to enter. For clarity, goats attending any non-MGBA shows that allow untested animals, or animals of unknown status, or where animals enter without requirement of laboratory reports, will be classed as having been in contact with untested animals.

INSPECTION OF EXHIBITS

MGBA Breed Standards, Heights and Regulations will govern breed related issues IN ALL CASES. All Animals aged 6 months and over must be measured in using the official show height bars and/or piccolo stick

prior to the commencement of judging and are to be brought up to the measuring station as directed by the steward. Animals not measured or deemed to be over show height will not be permitted to show. They may stay on the grounds and remain in their pen.

Animals must have NLIS ear tag in place and Identification must be confirmed prior to commencement of judging. (Any goats entering under dairy exemption must still have their ear tags present at the show). Goats may enter with microchip identification where they have a written ear tag exemption provided they have a microchip scanner for check-in. Animals should be good breed examples and no horns or scurs over 5cm.

ARRIVAL & DEPARTURE

Vehicles will be directed to **DESIGNATED PARKING AREAS** & must follow the direction of the steward(s).

JUDGING

Judging will commence at 10:00am or as per Chief Steward on the day.

PREPARATION OF EXHIBITS AND CLEANLINESS OF PENS

Exhibitors must keep the pens allotted to their animals clean, and give proper attention to their stock throughout the show. Exhibitors must provide their own bedding (unless indicated otherwise) and must provide their own feed, and feed and water containers.

STUD BANNERS

Stud banners will be restricted to the mesh area above the pens and may be displayed upon arrival. Banners must be no larger than 1400mm in length and 540mm in depth and must not hang below the mesh area. Banners, advertising or sales signs must be removed if directed. All signage must face away from the show ring and view of officiating Judge.

DRESS CODE

ALL Handlers will be required to wear MGBA attire and solid boots or strong enclosed shoes. No shorts, jeans (other than standard jeans) or open shoes. Handlers not properly attired will be denied entry to the show ring. No stud identification of any kind to be worn by the exhibitor, or displayed on the collar or lead or ear tag of the exhibit.

SUPPORTER PRIZES

Prizes are provided by third parties and the MGBA advises that any such prize may be subject to change or amendment occurring at any time, thereby making the original information published incorrect.

PRIZES: Exhibitors are responsible for collecting prizes on the day of the show and any prizes not collected (or surplus) will be forfeited and returned to the MGBA prize pool for future event/s.

PRIZE MONEY: Prize money not collected by 4pm on the day of the show (when paid on the show day) or when payment is by direct deposit: exhibitors bank details are to be provided to the MGBA Treasurer by close of business, Friday the week after the show (or date and time indicated by MGBA Treasurer) or prize money will be forfeited. All surplus or forfeited prize money will be returned to the MGBA show funds.

BREEDS

Animals are only eligible to enter ONE breed type section class as listed on their registration.

A) AUSTRALIAN MINIATURE - ≤12.5% imported genetics (either ND, or PY or a combination of both).

Does not to exceed 57cm; Bucks / Wethers not to exceed 60cm; Animals 3 years & over must measure at least 40.6cm

B) NIGERIAN DWARF – must be DNA verified proven to minimum 50% Nigerian Dwarf (DNA parental verification back to a known import, proving the Exhibit is carrying at least 50% Nigerian Dwarf genetics).

Does not to exceed 57cm; Bucks / Wethers not to exceed 60cm; Animals 3 years & over must measure at least 43.1cm

C) PYGMY –must be DNA verified proven to minimum 50% Pygmy (DNA parental verification back to a known import, proving the Exhibit is carrying at least 50% Pygmy genetics).

Does not to exceed 57cm; Bucks / Wethers not to exceed 60cm; Animals 3 years & over must measure at least 40.6cm

D) NUWBY – not permitted to carry more than *12.5% imported genetics. Does not to exceed 60cm; Bucks/wethers not to exceed 63.5cm *for 2025

(First Place is not counted). <u>EACH</u> progeny can accrue points as above, accumulated for their SIRE at each show (minimum 5pts for a sire per show to be eligible for accrual).
