1. **NO ENTRY FEE**
2. Online registrations are accepted at any time.
3. Judging will be performed by a panel of judges appointed by the Tweed River Agricultural Society.
4. No prize money will be awarded for any class except for the ASC Rich Fruit Cake Competition.
5. All Exhibits must be a bona fide work of the Exhibitor, grown or made by the individual.
6. All exhibits will remain on display until dismantling on Sunday 2nd November when they will be removed under the supervision of the Steward.
7. No exhibit may compete in more than one class.
8. Adult exhibitors may only compete in Open classes, but Children can compete in Children's and Open classes
9. **Deliveries will not be accepted** at the Secretary's Office at the Showground.
10. All exhibits must be picked up from the Pavilion on Sunday 2nd November, between 9.00 am and 11.00 am.
11. TRAS does not accept responsibility for any items remaining after that time. Exhibits will not remain stored on the site after noon on Sunday 2nd November.

- S2.3** Potatoes - Sweet Gold/Red - minimum 1kg
- S2.4** Potatoes - Collection (3 varieties) minimum 1kg
- S2.5** Mushrooms - White/Flat/Cup - minimum 250g
- S2.6** Mushrooms - Brown/Portabello - minimum 250g
- S2.7** Mushrooms - Exotic individual - minimum 250g
- S2.8** Nuts - Macadamia, Pecan, or other ground nuts - minimum 500g
- S2.9** Hen Eggs - 1 dozen
- S2.10** Bantam Eggs - 8 minimum
- S2.11** Duck Eggs - 8 minimum
- S2.12** Eggs - other individual variety - 8 minimum

- S2.22** Root Vegetables - any one of the following: Carrots x 6, Radishes x 6, Parsnips x 6
- S2.23** Leaf Vegetables - any one of the following: Cabbage (any) x 1, Cauliflower x 1, Broccoli/Broccolini x 1, Lettuce (any) x 1, Chinese Greens x 1
- S2.24** Stem Vegetables - any one of the following: Silverbeet x 6 stalks, Kale x 6 stalks, Spinach x 6 stalks, Celery x 6 stalks, Rhubarb x 6 stalks
- S2.25** Bulb Vegetables - any one of the following: Onions x 3, Garlic x 3, Leeks x 3, Spring Onions x 6 stalks, Eschalots x 6 stalks
- S2.26** Pumpkin – any one variety – minimum 1 kg cut in half
- S2.27** Squash/ Cucumber - any one of the following: Squash, Marrow, Zucchini, Cucumber, Choko - minimum 500g
- S2.28** Tomatoes - any one of the following: Tomatoes red round x 6, Roma Tomatoes x 6, Other Tomatoes x 6,
- S2.29** Tomatoes – minimum 2 varieties of Tomatoes on plate - 3 x each variety
- S2.30** Chillies - any one of the following: Chillies (any) x 6, Capsicum x 3, Eggplant x 3
- S2.31** Salad Vegetables - Collection of 5 named varieties (including tomatoes)
