1. **NO ENTRY FEE**
2. **Judging will be performed by a panel of judges appointed by the Tweed River Agricultural Society.**
3. **All Exhibits must have been completed within the last two years and not previously won a prize at the Murwillumbah Show.**
4. **All exhibits will remain on display until dismantling on Sunday 2nd November when they will be removed under the supervision of the Steward.**
5. **No exhibit may compete in more than one class.**
6. **Adult exhibitors may only compete in Open classes, but Children can compete in Children's and Open classes**
7. **Deliveries will not be accepted at the Secretary's Office at the Showground.**
8. **All exhibits must be picked up from the Pavilion on Sunday 2nd, November, between 9.00AM and 11.00PM**
9. **TRAS does not accept responsibility for any items remaining after that time. Exhibits will not remain stored on the site after noon on Sunday 2nd November.**
