The Directors are excited to announce that the Tweed River Agricultural Society has made a significant financial contribution toward the latest upgrade to the Showground power supply infrastructure.

The Murwillumbah Showground Land Managers have engaged contractors to install several new power poles and outlets along the eastern side of the ground and one on the western side where power has been unavailable near the grandstands. This will provide many more outlets for Trade Space sites at the annual Show.

It is very satisfying to see that funds raised by holding our Show can be utilised for maintaining and improving our fabulous grounds for the benefit of TRAS and the rest of the community.

It is a wonderful opportunity to connect with new friends and learn how to make a positive difference to your life and your community.

After some information and networking activities, one young woman will be selected to represent our local area at the Zone finals and from there, one young woman will represent the Far North Coast Zone at the Sydney Royal Easter Show in 2026, with accommodation, meals and travel expenses paid. The young woman selected at the Sydney Royal, as the ambassador for NSW in 2026 receives prize money of \$7,500 and the opportunity to represent NSW Agricultural Shows and her local area at functions throughout the year.

The winner acts as an ambassador for NSW during her year and represents the RAS, AgShows NSW and her local Show society at functions during the year.
