REGULATIONS & HORSE COMPETITION RULES

1. ONLINE ENTRIES CLOSE 29 OCTOBER <https://showday.online/show/murwillumbah>
 - Classic Led Classes \$10 per class.
 - All Other Ring Events \$5 per class
 - Showjumping entries priced on a class-by-class basis, please refer to program.

LATE / ON-THE-DAY ENTRIES

- Horse/rider combinations already nominated online may enter additional classes on the day at the appropriate class fee.
 - One-the-day entries by horse/rider combinations not already entered online will have a \$5 late fee added to each class entered.
 - Horse Event on-the-day entries will be taken at the Nomination Office.
 - Showjumping on-the-day entries will be taken at the Showjumping Tent in Centre Ring.
2. ONLINE STABLE BOOKINGS CLOSE 29 OCTOBER 2026
\$15.00 per day for all stabling (includes Open Yards, Covered Yards and Stables). Stable Bookings will be policed.
 - Stables are booked for 24 hours from 6:30am to 6:30am.
 - Stables/yards must be vacated by 6:30am on the day of departure if not booked again for that day.
 - Stable bedding is not provided.
 - Stables must be cleaned, and bedding removed by departure time.
 - Bedding and manure must be deposited at designated manure collection points.
 - Portable yards are not allowed.
 - Electric fences are not permitted in camping or livestock areas of the Showground and are banned on the main parking area from 6am to 8pm Friday & Saturday. If erected outside these hours appropriate signage must be displayed.
 3. ONLINE CAMPING BOOKINGS CLOSE 29 OCTOBER 2026
Limited number of camp sites available @ \$15.00 per night. Camping Bookings will be policed.
 4. ENTRY TO THE SHOWGROUND
 - Entry for horse floats, trucks and accompanying vehicles VIA GATE 8 ONLY.

- Showground opens for horses @ 6.00 AM DST on Saturday 1 November 2025.
 - Friday entry for horses by pre-arrangement – please contact the Secretary to find out what hours Gate 8 will be open for horses to enter.
 - Everyone entering the Show must pay the Gate Entry Fee. This includes all horse section competitors and their entourage. Tickets available online via www.ticketebo.com.au
5. 7.30AM DST Centre Ring Judging commences
8.30AM DST Showjumpers Walk the Course
9.00AM DST Jumping commences
 6. Refunds will NOT be available online. Refunds must be applied for in writing to the TRAS Board via the TRAS Secretary and will be dealt with at the first Board Meeting after the Event. Where applicable, a doctor's certificate or a veterinary certificate must accompany all refund applications. Please go to our website to read a copy of our Refund Policy.
 7. DOGS must be on a lead and under strict control at all times. Competitors and Spectators must not bring dogs into Centre Ring. All dogs are the absolute responsibility of the owner/handler.
 8. Riding Age Limit is 3 years of age as at date of competition for leading rein and 5 years of age for independent riding.
 9. Helmets & Footwear – All riders are encouraged to wear a safety helmet compliant with the current Australian Standard. Showjumping competitors, OUT OF THE PADDOCK event riders and Sporting Event competitors of any age must wear a correctly fitted, approved safety helmet when mounted. All riders under the age of 18 years must wear a correctly fitted, approved safety helmet when mounted. All competitors and handlers must wear covered footwear when in the main arena.
 10. ATTIRE & GEAR - Competitors must be appropriately attired for the competition in which they are entering. Horses must be presented in appropriate saddlery (halter/bridle/bit/saddle) for the competition in which they are entering. OUT OF THE PADDOCK events (Ring 6) have other attire & gear rules – see p17.
 11. If required by law at the time of this event, copies of applicable travel documentation or movement records as may be in force at the time must be sighted by the Gate Entry staff.
 12. COMPETITOR WAIVER AND HORSE HEALTH & BIOSECURITY DECLARATION FORMS are at the back of this Schedule and are also available online. You must hand the completed forms to the Nomination Office staff, who will confirm your online entries and provide you with a wristband which permits entry to Centre Ring.
 13. A Late Entry Card will be issued for every late entry you make and must have the class, horse and competitor details clearly written on it. The completed card must be presented to the ring steward when you enter the event.

14. HORSE MEASURING: No official measuring will take place at this Event. If a question about height arises proof of height may be required. In the absence of proof, a decision will be at the absolute discretion of the Ringmaster(s)/Chief Steward.
15. BREED REGISTRATION - Breed society memberships and registrations must be current. A copy of registration papers must be produced to Ringmaster(s)/Ring Steward(s)/Judge(s) upon demand.
16. Where there are LESS THAN THREE ENTRIES in any class it will rest with the judge to decide whether the exhibit(s) are worthy to receive a prize.
17. AGES OF ALL HORSES are computed from 1 August, except for Standardbreds, whose age is computed from 1 September.
18. HORSES MUST BE FREE FROM UNSOUNDNESS in all classes.
19. GROOMS, COMPETITORS, AND OTHERS IN CHARGE OF EXHIBITS MUST OBEY THE ORDERS OF THE RINGMASTERS, CHIEF STEWARD OR OTHER HORSE STEWARDS or they will be ejected from the grounds.
20. ONLY COMPETITORS ARE ALLOWED IN CENTRE RING. Competitors, their connections, or the general public may not gather in Centre Ring or make use of the Judge's and Horse Steward's marquee and facilities. This rule will be strongly enforced.
21. HORSES/COMPETITORS MUST MARSHAL ON THE TROTTING TRACK adjacent to the ring in which they are competing and wait to be called to the Ring by a Steward.
22. HORSES/COMPETITORS MUST NOT BLOCK THE ENTRY/EXIT GATE to Centre Ring.
23. SUPREME CHAMPION LED EXHIBITS & QEII QUALIFICATION - 1st Place winners from ANY Led Filly/Mare, Led Gelding, or Led Colt/Stallion Class eligible to compete in appropriate Supreme Champion Led event. Supreme Champion Led Filly/Mare, Supreme Champion Led Gelding, Supreme Champion Led Colt/Stallion may then compete for QEII Supreme Led Exhibit of Show.
24. SUPREME CHAMPION HACKS & HUNTERS – Champions from all Hack events eligible to compete for Supreme Champion Hack of the Show. Champions from all Show Hunter events eligible to compete for Supreme Show Hunter. Champions from all Working Hunter events eligible to compete for Supreme Working Hunter.
25. YOU ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR BEING IN CENTRE RING IN TIME FOR YOUR EVENT. Classes will not wait for multi-registered horses or handlers/riders competing in other ring(s). If you do not present in time for an event, judging will proceed

without you. Once judging has commenced a competing horse may not be led, ridden or driven into or out of the judging ring without the permission of the Judge and/or Ringmaster(s) or Chief Steward.

26. CENTRE RING EVENTS ARE IN THE HANDS OF THE RINGMASTER. While every effort will be made to follow the program, the Ringmaster reserves the right to alter the events and/or event schedule. If in the Ringmaster's opinion conditions (e.g. extreme weather) make it advisable not to conduct all or any of the ring events because of danger to competitors, the Ringmaster shall convene a meeting, comprising the TRAS President, Deputy Ringmaster(s) and Ringmaster and a majority decision of this sub-committee shall be final. TRAS does not indemnify competitors in any way for events so cancelled.
27. APPROACHING JUDGES – no exhibitor or associate will initiate conversation with a Judge on judging day, before, during or after judging, except through the Ringmaster or Chief Steward.
28. PROHIBITED RELATIONSHIP – no competitor will present for judging before a judge with whom he/she has a family relationship, has or has had a personal relationship or has had horse related dealings within the past twelve months.
29. COACHING – Any person detected coaching a competitor while that competitor is being judged may be removed from the Showground and that competitor may be disqualified from the event.
30. COMPETITORS MAY NOT RIDE MORE THAN ONE (1) HORSE IN A CLASS. This regulation may be waived in Championships or Supreme competition at the discretion of the Ringmaster.
31. COLTS irrespective of breed or age, must be shown in a halter equipped with a restraining chain or bit. All Colts must display a green disk.
32. STALLIONS irrespective of breed or age, led or ridden, must be wearing a bit at all times and must be under the control of a person aged 17 years or older. Stallions may only compete in Stallion Classes except in showjumping and Western Performance Classes. All Stallions must display a green disk.
33. Competitors, their connections, and stewards, may protest. THE ONLY GROUNDS FOR PROTEST ARE ELIGIBILITY AND CONDUCT OF COMPETITORS. Protests must be made in writing and lodged with Ringmaster within 15 minutes of completion of judging of the disputed event: protests must be accompanied by a fee of \$50, refundable if the protest is upheld. Judge's decisions will be final and are not subject to protest.
34. CRUELTY - persons who are considered by a Judge, Ringmaster or Chief Steward to be abusive or cruel to a horse will be expelled from the grounds. No horse will be permitted to compete if in the opinion of the Judge, Ringmaster or Chief Steward it is in poor health or condition or unsound.

35. RANDOM DRUG TESTING may be carried out at this Event. Any competitor found to have breached the ASC Disputes and Disciplinary regulations will be investigated by the ASC Disciplinary Committee.
36. The Committee may, in its entire discretion, publish any decision of the Committee, including any penalty imposed, to the members of the ASC, Show Societies and Royal Show Societies throughout Australia, Equestrian Australia, the Show Horse Council of Australasia Inc. and to such other organizations conducting shows as express a clear interest in supporting ASC penalties. Where appropriate such publication may strongly recommend that relevant bodies support ASC penalties by extending any ASC suspension to include the shows held during that time by those relevant bodies. No action shall lie against the ASC, the Board, or any member of a Committee in respect of any such publication.
37. The Committee may determine by resolution that, when notified by another body of the suspension of an animal and/or a person (or persons) under the rules applicable to that body's showing rules, the suspension will be extended to include NSW agricultural shows, and the societies will be notified accordingly.
38. VETERINARY COSTS incurred at the Event are the responsibility of the exhibitor/owner of the animal treated.
39. A person who behaves offensively on the Showground may be expelled from the ground. ABUSIVE BEHAVIOUR TOWARDS JUDGES OR OFFICIALS WILL NOT BE TOLERATED. The matter may be further investigated by TRAS and/or ASC Disciplinary Committee and penalties may be imposed.
40. MAIDEN CLASSES are open to horses which have not won any hack class at an Agricultural Show.
41. NOVICE CLASSES are open to exhibits which have not won Champion or any Open Class at an Agricultural Show or First or Second at a Royal Show.
42. Horses may enter HACK or HUNTER classes but are not eligible to compete in both
43. HACKS and HUNTERS are to be presented/shown in accordance with Show Horse Council Rules.
44. OUT OF THE PADDOCK competitors are to be shown in accordance with the rules for that event, listed on p17.
45. DPI - TICK CONTROL NOTICE
Any competitors coming from Queensland must make their own arrangements to comply with the Department of Primary Industries (DPI) tick control rules. These rules will be enforced. Please contact the DPI if you have any queries: E| cattletick@dpi.nsw.gov.au P| 02 6626 1111
46. DPI – BIOSECURITY (FIRE ANT) EMERGENCY ORDER

Any competitors coming from Queensland must make their own arrangements to comply with the Department of Primary Industries (DPI) Biosecurity (Fire Ant) Emergency Order. Breaching this Order may incur a penalty of \$1,100,000 per individual. Please refer to the DPI website for further details on the Biosecurity (Fire Ant) Emergency Order.

47. TWEED SHIRE EVENTS entries are limited to exhibits owned & domiciled within the Tweed Shire for at least three (3) months prior to entries closing and if required by the Stewards a declaration to that effect must be signed by the competitor.
48. DISTRICT EVENTS entries are limited to exhibits owned and domiciled within Group 1 for at least three (3) months prior to entries closing and if required by the Stewards a declaration to that effect must be signed by the competitor.
49. THE GRAND PARADE is an important spectacle for Show Patrons. TRAS encourages all Horse Section competitors to proudly exhibit their animals.
