FARM PRODUCE

- S2.1** - Potatoes - White/Cream - minimum 1kg
- S2.2** - Potatoes - Red/Purple/Pink Eye - minimum 1kg
- S2.3** - Potatoes - Sweet Gold/Red - minimum 1kg
- S2.4** - Potatoes - Collection (3 varieties) - minimum 1kg
- S2.5** - Mushrooms - White/Flat/Cup - minimum 250g
- S2.6** - Mushrooms - Brown/Portabello - minimum 250g
- S2.7** - Mushrooms - Exotic individual - minimum 250g
- S2.8** - Nuts - Macadamia/Pecan/other ground nuts in their shell - minimum 250g

EGGS

- S2.9** - Hen Eggs - 1 dozen
- S2.10** - Bantam Eggs - 8 minimum
- S2.11** - Duck Eggs - 8 minimum

FRUIT

- S2.16** - Citrus Fruit - any one of the following - Oranges/Mandarins/Grapefruit/lemons/limes - 3 pieces
- S2.17** - Citrus Fruit - Collection of 3 from above - 2 each (6)
- S2.18** - Fruit in Season - Bananas (1 hand) Passionfruit (6) Avocados (3) Other (4)
- S2.19** - Collection of Fruits - 6 Varieties

VEGETABLES

- S2.20** - Legumes - Any one of Beans/Peas - minimum 500g
- S2.21** - Root Veg - Any one of Beetroot/Kohlrabi/Swede/Turnips - 3 pieces
- S2.22** -- Root Veg - Any one of Carrots/Radishes/Parsnips - 6 pieces
- S2.23** - Leaf Vegetables - any one of Cabbage/Cauliflower/Broccoli/Broccilni/Lettuce (any)/Chinese Greens (1)
- S2.24** - Steam Vegetables - any one of Silverbeet/Kale/Spinach/ Celery/Rhubarb - 6 stalks

- S2.28** - Tomatoes - any one of Red Round/Roma/Other - 6 pieces
- S2.29** - Tomatoes - minimum 2 varieties of Tomatoes on a plate - 3 of each variety
- S2.30** - Chillies - any one of Chillies/Capsicum/Eggplant - 3 pieces
- S2.31** - Salad Vegetables - Collection of 5 named varieties (includes tomatoes)
- S2.32** - Vegetables - Collection of 5 named varieties (does not include tomatoes)
- S2.33** - Vegetables - Largest specimen of any one from classes S2.20 to S2.30
- S2.34** - Special Class for Primary Children - Collection of Fruit & Vegetables - minimum 6 varieties on a plate.
